### **BISHOP BROSSART SUMMER K-8 DRAMA CAMP**

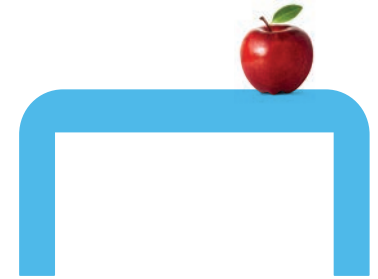
