Parish Center opening for public masses due to new protocols: Our first mass will be Wednesday, May 20th at 8:30 am followed by Friday, May 22nd at 8:30 am in the Parish Center as a trial run since we don't know the possible turn out. In addition, all **Weekend Masses** will be in the Parish Center too. To keep proper distance, the chairs will set up by different groupings. Families can be next to each other so we will have groups of chairs in numbers of 8, 6, 4, 2 and singles to accommodate the different sizes. For the choirs, we are being asked at the beginning that there be no music. We will get you going as soon as possible.

The messenger will have the finalized details for us to follow. I ask you to observe them with an open mind and charitable heart. I genuinely believe that they are created for political purposes but the safety of all. For some they may seem ridged or over cautious and to some may not be strict enough. We are all different so in this regard please consider others fears, skepticism and feelings. At my ordination I made a promise of obedience so we will try our best to make the celebration of the Lord's Supper as meaningful and reverent as possible under the new protocols.

I am excited in getting things rolling again and seeing your faces at Mass. Thank all of you for your prayers and well wishes during this difficult time.
